

LEARNING FOCUS - TERM 3

Mathematics - In Mathematics, we are continuing to work on students basic facts knowledge along with a focus on the strand of Measurement.

Literacy - In Writing we are focussing on persuasive writing and speeches. In Reading we will be learning to apply comprehension strategies such as inferencing.

P.E - This term we have cross country where the focus is on stamina, pacing and technique.

Arts Programme - Beginning in Week 4: Rm1 - Science, Rm2 - Maori/French, Rm3 -Dance/Drama, Rm4 - Visual Arts, Rm5 - Science

Topic - *“Financial Literacy”* - *The students will be given a budget to plan a trip with the purpose of attending one or more of the Rugby World Cup games.*

Māori - Te Reo lessons based around waiata, games and communicating with each other using basic phrases.
